**PARENTS:** This system allows YOU to access your child’s daily classroom behavior and also receive weekly reports. It is simple! Just follow these 3 steps below to set up your Class Dojo log in:

- 2.) Enter: your parent code
- 3.) Enter: your name, email & create a password
